WHAT DOES THE APPRENTICESHIP ENTAIL?

As an Apprentice at Gordons, you will be employed by the firm full-time whilst studying one day a week with BPP University. The route to qualification as a Solicitor takes 6 years and during that time Gordons will pay you a salary, provide study leave and sponsor your training fees.

The apprenticeship is split into two parts:

- Years 1-2 Paralegal Apprenticeship (includes BPP Level 4 Certificate in Higher Education)
- Years 3-6 Solicitor Apprenticeship (includes LLB law degree and Solicitors Qualifying Exams)

On completion of all stages and passing all examinations and end point assessments you will qualify as Solicitor at the firm and hold a Level 7 qualification.

- Reside within easy travelling distance of our Leeds and Bradford offices
- Be available to attend the assessment day at our office in Leeds, which is part of the selection process
